## Middle School Uniform

Because so many Middle School students have been arriving to school out of uniform, we thought it would be a good time to go over the HAAS Middle School Uniform Policy.

1. All uniform tops must be a blue or white button down oxford uniform shirt, *tucked in*, Monday through Thursday. The top two buttons may be unbuttoned.
2. Only solid white, red, or navy t-shirts may be worn under the uniform shirt.
3. On Fridays, Middle School students may wear any HAAS sanctioned t-shirt.
4. White or Navy PE Shirts can only be worn on PE days and *must be worn on Field Trips*.
5. All bottoms (pants, shorts, or skorts) must be *uniform brands*. A list of accepted brands can be found on the School Information Page on the school website [www.hollywoodcharter.org](http://www.hollywoodcharter.org).
6. All students must wear a belt when uniform bottoms have belt loops.
