



2008-2009 Supply List Kindergarten

On the following pages, are **two lists** of supplies that your child will need to bring to school. Please note that the **first list is due August 15th, for Orientation Day**, and the **second list is due** the first day back from Winter Break, **on January 5th, 2009**.

Some of these items are to be shared and used in class. Please do not label these items with your child's name, as they will be shared. Please send all items to school in a large, closed plastic bag labeled with your child's name and grade level –kindergarten. Bring the items on orientation day/Meet and Greet. **Please label *only* the items that we requested to label. Everything else will be shared.**

Please understand that we are specific about the type of items we request that you purchase because they have been tested in the classroom and, based on our experience, the items listed are the most suitable for kindergarten children and are more durable than other products.

Please bring to Orientation Day, August 15th 8:30 – 10:00 am :

- 15 chubby pencils, preferably triangular-shaped and Dixon Ticonderoga brand, Tri-Rex or another premium brand. Most other brands break easily. These pencils are sometimes called "My First Pencils".
- One pencil sharpener.
- 4 packages of Crayola jumbo-sized crayons (or large), preferably with one flat side so they don't roll.
- 3 packages of washable markers
- 8 erasers
- 1 pair of blunt, metal (not plastic) child-safe scissors to use in class
- 1 package large or small construction paper (preferably, loose in package, with colors separate-not the kind that needs to be torn from a book)
- 1 package of kindergarten handwriting paper, with **very large-spaced lines**, any brand (such as Mead or Post-it.) Paper with a space to draw a picture above the lines is desirable. Thick paper that has protruding lines is also preferable.
- 1 hardcover journal of handwriting paper with wide-spaced lines and a space for drawing a picture at the top
- One **plastic** 2-pocket, 3-prong **purple** folder, labeled on the front with a permanent marker: "Poetry Folder" and your child's name
- One **plastic** 2-pocket **red** folder, labeled on the front: "Homework Folder" and your child's name
- One **plastic** 2-pocket **blue** folder, labeled on the front: "Communication Folder" and your child's name (**Important Note:** Please **DO NOT** purchase any loose-leaf binders or any other kind of folder other than those specified above. It is **very important** that each child has all three binders, as specified above, to help keep his/her papers organized and orderly and to simplify communication between home and school.)
- 5 packages disinfectant wipes for hands
- 4 extra-large bottles of hand disinfecting gel, such as Purell
- 4 rolls of paper towels
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 four-pack of Play-Doh brand play dough
- 1 package of medium-sized plastic cups
- **Optional: 1 bottle of Clorox blue spray or Method cleaning spray (available at Target,) any kind**

Please send in the following items on January 5th, 2009, after Winter Break:

- 15 chubby pencils, preferably triangular-shaped and Dixon Ticonderoga brand, Tri-Rex or another premium brand. Most other brands break easily. These pencils are sometimes called "My First Pencils". If they come with a pencil sharpener, you may keep the pencil sharpener at home or send it to school.

2008-2009 Supply List 1st Grade

- 3 durable plastic folders (no name) - one **red**, one **blue** and one **purple**
- personal pencil sharpener
- crayons
- composition book
- glue stick
- scissors
- school box with name on it (pencil box)
- pencils (Good quality ones, such as Ticonderoga or Try-Rex, typically last longer.)
- one package of construction paper, any size
- markers (optional)
- colored pencils (optional)
- one box of tissues
- two packages of antibacterial wipes for hands
- two extra-large bottles of antibacterial gel
- one bottle of Clorox "Anywhere" spray (optional)
- one roll of paper towels (optional)
- tempera paint (optional)

Parents may be requested to replenish their children's pencil box supplies as necessary throughout the school year. They also may be requested to help with classroom supplies. When helping with classroom supplies, please save your receipts and submit them to your child's teacher attached to a volunteer hour form. You will receive 1 volunteer hour for every \$10 spent on the above classroom supplies. You may not receive volunteer hours for your child's personal school supplies, supplies that you buy for your child's use at home, or supplies for your child's backpack.

- 2 hand-held pencil/crayon sharpeners with twin holes
- 1 box of pencil-top erasers
- 1 pack standard 3x5 index cards

- 2 bottles hand sanitizer

- Separate spiral notebook for **each** subject with **perforated** edges to tear out: Reading, Math, Social Studies, Science, Writing/L.A.
- 6 folders with double sided pockets: 5 for the subjects and 1 designated as a “Homework Folder”
- 2 boxes of Number 2 pencils
- 1 package of loose leaf paper – wide ruled
- 1 pencil box- to keep all materials inside
- 1 composition book
- 1 box of crayons – no markers or colored pencils please
- 1 pair of good scissors
- 1 package of dry erase markers (bring in one – keep the rest at home for replacements)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 package of “refill” wet wipe (any brand)- to clean
- 1 package of #2 pencils (bring in two – keep the rest at home for replacements)
- 1 highlighter
