



Kindergarten Student Supply List 2010-2011

Our Kindergarten students need both writing supplies and supplies to help keep our classroom neat and tidy. Please understand that we are specific about the type of items we request that you purchase because they have been tested in the classroom and, based on our experience, the items listed are the most suitable for kindergarten children and are more durable than other products.

NOTE: The supplies listed below are your child's starting kit for the Kindergarten school year. The supplies listed below do not earn volunteer hours.

The following is the list of supplies your child will need to bring to school on Orientation Day, August 20, 2010. Please purchase the following items, to be used in class. *Please send all items to school in a large, closed plastic bag labeled with your child's name, teacher's name and KG.*

- **15** Chubby pencils either Dixon Ticonderoga brand, Tri-Rex or another premium brand. Most other brands break easily. These pencils are sometimes called "My First Pencils".
- **4** Packs of Crayola or Rose Art jumbo-sized crayons
- **2** Packs of 24 pack standard Crayola or Rose Art Crayons
- **2** Packs of Crayola or Rose Art washable markers
- **2** Bottles of Elmer's School Glue (4 oz)
- **15** Small Elmers glue sticks
- **1** pair of Fiskars scissors (blunt, metal-*not plastic*, child-safe) to use in class

- **1** Package large or small construction paper (preferably, loose in package, with separated colors- not the kind that needs to be torn from a book)
 - **1 plastic 2-bottom pocket yellow folder** labeled on the front: **“Homework Folder”** and your child’s name
 - **1 plastic 2-bottom pocket blue folder**, labeled on the front: **“Communication Folder”** and your child’s name
 - **1 plastic 3-prong purple folder**, labeled on the front with a permanent marker: **“Poetry Folder”** and your child’s name
 - **NOTE: *Please DO NOT purchase any loose-leaf binders or any other kind of folder other than those specified above.**

- **6** containers of disinfectant wipes for hands (not baby wipes), preferably size: 60 plus sheets in the container (NO travel packs, please)
 - **1** Extra-large bottle or 2 - 12 oz bottles of hand disinfecting gel, such as Purell
 - **5** Rolls of paper towels
 - **2** Box of tissue- (normal size rectangular box)
 - **1** Four-pack of Play-Dough brand play dough

- **1** HAAS Agenda – to be purchased at school

FINAL NOTE: Any other items requested by the teacher during the school year will qualify for volunteer hours. You will receive 1 volunteer hour for every \$10.00 spent.
