Your child **MUST** complete a book report for every book. If you would like to get a head start, the **ONLY** form that will be accepted is page 3. 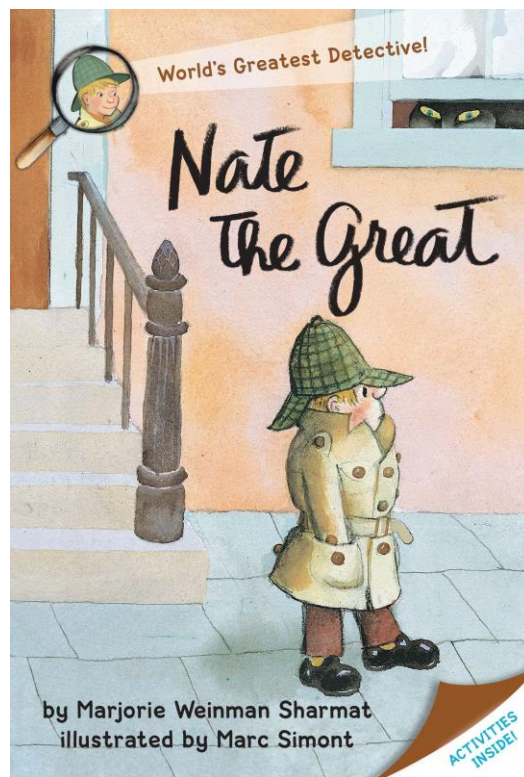
